

Day 01: Arrive Delhi

Morning after leisurely breakfast we leave for a sightseeing tour of Old & New Delhi. In Old Delhi where we visit Jama Masjid, this immense mosque is both the largest in India and the final architectural extravagance of Shah Jahan with a courtyard capable of holding 25,000 devotees, . The highlight of the tour is an exhilarating bicycle rickshaw ride through the bustling and colourful streets of the fabled shopping bazaar, Chandni Chowk (Silver Street). We drive past Red Fort citadel and reach Raj Ghat, a memorial to Mahatma Gandhi is a simple black marble platform that marks the spot of his cremation on 31 January, 1948. Two museums dedicated to Gandhi are located nearby. In New Delhi we visit the 11th century Qutab Minar Tower, a UNESCO World Heritage Site built by Qutub-ud-din Aibek of the Slave Dynasty, who took possession of Delhi in 1206. It is a red sandstone tower, standing tall at a height of 72.5 metres and is covered with intricate carvings and verses from the holy Qur'an. The India Gate, a memorial raised in honour of the Indian soldiers martyred during the Afghan war and drive past the grand government buildings the President's House and Parliament House all dating back to the time of British Raj. Overnight at hotel.

Day 03: Delhi / Jaipur (250 Km / 5 Hrs)

Later in the evening we explore the city on our own and indulge in shopping for gemstones, silver jewellery, Paintings, blue pottery and hand printed textiles that Jaipur is renowned for. Overnight at hotel.

Day 05: Jaipur/Fatehpur Sikri/Agra (250 Km / 5 Hrs)

After breakfast we drive leisurely to the home of the breathtaking white-marble Taj Mahal - Agra, takes us through the images of rural India. Agra was established as the Mughal capital in 1526 and is known for its chaotic and vibrant marketplace (chowk), endless auto rickshaw touts, plentiful souvenir vendors, historic temples and many grand, ancient monuments and tombs. Enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri a UNESCO World Heritage Site which has been described as Day 08: Orchha / Khajuraho (200 Km / 04 Hrs) "the world's most perfectly preserved ghost town". Built by Akbar in the late 16th century, it was abandoned after only 14 years, and the elegant buildings of this superb walled city remain intact to this day. Overnight at hotel.



Day 06: Agra

After breakfast our drive takes us to Khaiuraho, the legendary temples of Khajuraho built in the 9th and the 10th century are an incomparable experience. Acknowledged as one of the world's artistic wonders. Khajuraho has achieved fame for the sensual appeal of its erotic sculptures. On arrival we check inn to our Hotel. Post lunch we visit the exquisite 10th century temples of Khajuraho, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Evening we witness the fascinating Son-et-Lumière spectacle evokes the life and times of the great Chandela Kings and traces the story of the unique temples from the 10th Century to the present day. Mounted in the complex of the Western Group of temples. Overnight at hotel.

Day 09: Khajuraho - Varanasi 1325/1415)

After leisurely breakfast, Transfer to Khajuraho airport for flight to Varanasi. Meeting at airport and transfers to the hotel. On the way visit to Sarnath, where Buddha in deer park, having received his divine enlightenment, held his first sermon in 528 BC, called Dharamachakra (wheel of law), the basic principles of his teaching. In the park is sacred Bo tree under which Buddha stood and a temple (stupa) in which stored urn with relics of the Buddha. Evening visiting and enjoying Ganga Arti - sacred Hindu ritual on the banks of the Ganges River, where a beating of drums, chanting of mantras, throwing on flowers in the water, incense and lighted torches express worship before deities and sacred river. Overnight at hotel.

Day 10: Fly Varanasi / Delhi & Depart Home (SG 119, 1615/1740)

Day 07: Agra / Orchha (225 Km / 04 Hrs)

This morning we drive towards **Orchha**, The town was established by Maharaja Rudra Pratap Singh in 1501, as the seat of an eponymous former princely state of central India, in the Bundelkhand region. Orchha lies on the Betwa River set amongst a complex of well-preserved palaces and temples. Post lunch sightseeing of Orchha including visit to the Fort, The fort is reached by an arched bridge and the three palaces set in an open courtyard within the fort are the first buildings to explore. The tiered Jahangir Mahal was built in 1606 to commemorate the visit of Emperor Jahangir. The Raj Mahal, to the right of the courtyard, was built by Madhukar Shah and has bold colorful murals inside. The third palace, Rai Praveen Mahal, which is a two storey brick structure set in the gardens of Anand Mahal. Of the many temples within the
